There will be a mounted prize giving for top ten in the CIC2** and unmounted (but in the main arena) for the CIC1* - top ten. **Friday:** CIC Dressage will take place, alongside I, OI, and N Classes. **Saturday:** CIC Dressage will take place, alongside N and BE100 classes. **Sunday:** CIC SJ and XC. Stabling

Some stabling on site. Stables not available until 18:00 on Thursday. Onsite Monarch Indoor Barn stabling is £130 per stable for three night bookings only (inc. two bales shavings on first night). Onsite show ground temporary stabling is £97 up to two nights, £125 for three nights. Stabling in the main farm yard is £40.00 per night and is located a 10 min walk on horse from showground. The above stabling is based on a first come, first served basis. No stabling refunds after ballot date. On commencement of competition once stables have been entered there will be no refund in the case of cancellation or

abandonment. Any refunds given will be less £12 admin fee per stable. Electric hookup £15 per night, £52.50 inc VAT min charge. Sticker must be collected from stable manager upon arrival. This will be monitored. Course description

Somerford's courses are designed by David Evans and built by the Somerford Park Team and will be following the

same route with some changes to all courses. The CIC1*/2** track will be up to height and bold. The flowing Cross Country courses run over permanent undulating grassland around the old Somerford Park Estate, and are designed in a traditional style to encourage bold riding, including two water complexes with man-made take-offs and landings. Every effort is made to ensure good going with all courses dressed to create a championship feel. Dressage located on level ground within the permanent 80-acre showground. CIC1*/2* Dressage will be on a surfaced arena to ensure good going for all. The Show Jumping and warm-up will be on the Andrews Bowen surface.
